RESOLUTION No. 15/2010

of 24 February 2010

on establishment of a macro-field of study “European Diplomacy” as a full-time and part-time undergraduate programme.

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of the 27 July 2005, article 11, section 4, the Senate of the University of Wrocław resolves the following:

§1

With the beginning of the 2010/2011 academic year, a macro-field of study under the name of “European Diplomacy” is established as a full-time and part-time three-year undergraduate programme at The Faculty of Social Sciences.

§2

The Study Programme and Curriculum are enclosed in Annex 1 and Annex 2 to the Resolution.

§3

The Resolution takes effect on the date it is passed.
